# COLOMBIAN COOPERATION STRATEGY WITH THE CARIBBEAN

## I Official visit to The Caribbean

#### St. Vincent and the Grenadines, Dominica and St. Kitts and Nevis

From March 13 to 15 2017, a delegation from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Colombia (Americas and International Cooperation Divisions), accompanied by the Ministry of Commerce, visited St. Vincent and the Grenadines, Dominica and St. Kitts and Nevis. As part of the agenda, the delegation held meetings with representatives of the Ministries of Foreign Affairs of the three countries and with other governmental authorities. In addition, they reviewed the status of the bilateral relationship and the advances of the cooperation initiatives currently under implementation.
